## RUSSIAN PRESENTS FILM TO NSF

A leading Soviet geomorphologist, Dr. Udintsev serves as Head, Laboratory of Geophysics and Tectonics of the Ocean Floor, Department of Marine Geology at the Institute of Oceanology.

Dr. G. B. Udintsev, a member of the U.S.-U.S.S.R. Joint Committee on Cooperation in World Ocean Studies, was in Washington, D.C. last month to discuss projects of that Committee and to present a copy of the motion picture film, "The Earth Beneath the Sea," which is a record of Sino-Soviet expeditions, including some sponsored by the U.S./U.S.S.R. Committee. The main theme of the film is the geophysical investigation of the structure of the oceanic crust, island areas, and ocean trenches.
